## STRANGER DANGER

All children in P5-7 who walk home or to meeting points should go straight to these places. This is reinforced in school. If the adult is not at the meeting point, pupils must return to school and wait safely.

All pupils entered need to be ready for these exams with substantial practising completed at home.



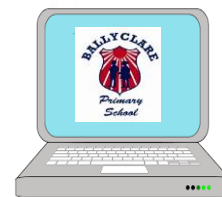
## TOLLYMORE TRIP – FINAL PAYMENT
