REMINDER

All parents please note that school will end for all pupils tomorrow – Friday at 1:55pm to ensure our Fair is set up and ready for 6:00pm start. Come along and enjoy the fun!

For safety reasons, all pupils must be accompanied at the Fair by a parent/known adult for supervision, as it is in the evening. Staff will not be in this role as they will be working at the fair events.

SPORTS' DAY – WEDNESDAY 6th JUNE



As you know our Sports' Day is to take place on Wednesday 6th June. We are hopeful for a good day. To help with work arrangements the following information may be useful.

P1-4 Sports will run from 9:30 – 11:45am. Children enter school at 8:45am in the normal way. Parents go straight to the Sports Field. After the end of the Sports, P1-4 children leave with their parents/family members.

P5-7 Sports will run from 12:45 – 3:00pm (approx). Pupils will return to school to collect their belongings and leave school immediately after this exciting event.

More details are on the website attached to last week's bulletin. Please note that any younger child returning in the afternoon to watch their older brother or sister should be seated or stand with their parent/s. No children should be running about unsupervised for safety reasons. As you know, children taking part in the sports will be seated with their teachers. For Child Protection reasons – no other adults should walk over to this area. We will have hot dogs/tea/coffee and ice-cream available for sale.

Packed lunches/dinner money/drinks for sports/inhalers etc should come to school in the morning with your child. Please do not bring these to the sports field to deliver to children while they are seated with their class teacher. In the event of your child forgetting to bring their packed lunch, one will be provided in school and the money can be sent the next day.

*If we are not able to run Sports' Day, we will text all parents at 9.15am.
There is no need to ring the school office.*

Should sports be cancelled for weather reasons, the children will be staying in school. Sports Day will then be run on Thursday 7th June, if it is dry, at the set times.

EXTENDED SCHOOL ACTIVITIES & BUDGET ISSUES

Our pupils have had lots of opportunities this year to enjoy different sporting, cultural, musical, scriptural and skills based activities after school.
